Prior to joining Straumann in 2006 as CFO and Executive Vice President Operations, he was with the international Swiss food group Hero for five years, where he also held the office of CFO and was responsible for IT operations. Before that, he spent nine years at building supplies group Hilti in diverse sales and management roles as well as in various regions. Further stations of his career were Sandoz International AG, where he worked as an audit manager, and the Corporate Finance department at Swiss Bank Corporation (now UBS) in Basel.

He has been Chairman of the Board of Directors of Swiss textile group Calida since April 2019 and a member of the Board of Directors of Mettler-Toledo.
